Grant of Conditional Permission to Saifia Hamidia Unani Tibbia College & Hospital, Near Ganpati Naka, Khandwa Road, Burhanpur-450331 Madhya Pradesh (Inst. ID: UNI0291) with 50 seats in UG (BUMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24 and for issuance of Letter or Permission (LOP) for increase intake capacity in existing UG (BUMS) course from 50 seats to 60 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2023-24 and relevant regulations thereunder-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act,1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

- 1. I am to refer your application vide reference no. SHUT/2022/14 dated 26.10.2022 received from The Principal, Saifia Hamidia Unani Tibbia College & Hospital, Near Ganpati Naka, Khandwa Road, Burhanpur-450331 Madhya Pradesh for seeking permission of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, National Commission for Indian System for increase of seats in existing UG (BUMS) course from 50 to 60 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic session 2023-24. Further, to verify the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff and other facilities available at your college for issuance of Letter of Intent (LOI), the visitation held on 22-23.06.2023 through hybrid mode by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board (NCISM). Accordingly, as per the fullfilment the criteria for issuance of Letter of Intent (LOI), the Letter of intent (LOI) was issued to you for increase of seats in existing UG (BUMS) course from 50 seats to 60 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic session 2023-24 vide letter ref. No. 11-17/2023-24/MARB/UNANI/NP(13A) dated 11.09.2023.
- 2. Further, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) had again carried out an inspection of your college on 25.09.2023 and 26.09.2023 on hybrid mode to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college to process the issuance of conditional permission for conducting 50 seats in UG (BUMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24 and to process for issuance of Letter of Permission (LOP) for increase intake capacity in existing UG (BUMS) course from 50 seats to 60 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2023-24.
- 3. In view of the above, the visitation report and other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely "the Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019; Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Unani Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations 2016"; provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder. Further, the assessment report was placed in the 63rd Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 04.10.2023. On careful examination of the assessment report it was found that your college is fulfilling the notified and approved criteria for conducting 50 seats in UG (BUMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24 and for issuance of Letter of Permission (LOP) for increase intake capacity in existing UG (BUMS) course from 50 seats to 60 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2023-24.
- 4. Further, in accordance of the regulation 6(3)(j)(i) of "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019 vide letter of even no. dated 09.10.2023 a letter was sent to you to furnish fixed security deposit worth Rupees Twenty Five Lakh Only (Rs. 25,00,000/-) in favor of National Commission fund for Indian system of Medicine for the period of five years. In response of the same you have furnished the fixed security deposit in favor of the National Commission fund for Indian system of Medicine through NEFT/RTGS UTR No. UBINH2328347287 of Rupees Twenty

Five Lakh Only (Rs. 25, 00,000/-) dated 10.10.2023 for a period of five years and informed the same vide E-mail dated 10.10.2023.

- 5. Therefore, Conditional permission is granted to Saifia Hamidia Unani Tibbia College & Hospital, Near Ganpati Naka, Khandwa Road, Burhanpur Distt. Khandwa-450331, Madhya Pradesh with 50 seats in UG (BUMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24 and issuance of Letter of Permission (LOP) for increase intake capacity in existing UG (BUMS) course from 50 seats to 60 seats under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2023-24 subject to the condition that college is fulfilling the following requirements:-
- I. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
- II. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BUMS) course shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2023-24 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
- III. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref. no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
 - 6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
 - 7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
 - 8. Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or subsequent year.
 - 9. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2023 and compliance report should be sent to get permission for the academic session 2024-25:
 - all the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Unani Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - ii) The applicant shall fulfill all the relevant provisions of Regulations namely the "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019.
 - iii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Unani); and
 - iv) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto;
 - 10. This permission to increase in intake capacity in existing UG (BUMS) course from 50 seats to 60 seats from the academic session 2023-24 as stated above for the first admitted batch of 2023-24 session, will be valid till such time as the first batch of students admitted against these courses appear for the first final examination of the said courses and at that time, the College authorities may take up the matter for recognition of the qualifications under Section 35 of the NCISM Act 2020.
 - 11. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25.
